Golden with Delicate Taste

Light, golden color with a mild, delicate taste. Excellent as a table syrup or over ice cream or yogurt.



Amber with Rich Taste

A light amber color and full-bodied flavor, this class of syrup is the product of choice for consumers who desire the classic maple syrup flavor.



Dark with Robust Taste

A dark amber color with a more pronounced maple flavor, this class will satisfy those consumers who desire the strong flavors of what has been known as Grade B.



Very Dark with Strong Taste Nearly black, this syrup has a strong flavor

Nearly black, this syrup has a strong flavor that translates well to cooking, where the maple flavor will carry through to the finished dish.

Why the Change?

The maple syrup grades we had been using were based on a system created when maple syrup was a substitute for cane sugar, which was not widely available. Our new grades provide better descriptions, with each of the classifications having a color and flavor descriptor, helping our customers pinpoint the exact syrup they want to purchase.

International Alignment

For years, Vermont's four grades of maple syrup had differed from New York's, Maine's, Canada's and others. This created confusion within the marketplace and our new grades will be aligned with all other states and provinces, so that we all use the same grade names.
